

# Northwest Nassau Natural Gas Integrity Project

## Overview

National National Grid is making a significant investment to modernize our natural gas system in Northwest Nassau County. This project, known as the Northwest Nassau Natural Gas Integrity Project, will help upgrade and improve the safety of Long Island's gas system.

Since the project started in June 2017 National Grid has installed two regulator stations in Roslyn Heights and Old Westbury, and nearly 4 miles of new gas main on Old Westbury Road, Powerhouse Road, Locust Lane and Roslyn Road.

## What to Expect

Construction on the latest phase of the Northwest Nassau Natural Gas Integrity Project will begin in May 2021 just north of East Williston Avenue. We anticipate completing gas main installation at the intersection of Roslyn Road and Jericho Turnpike in the late Summer/ early Fall of 2021 and then continuing our work down to Old Country Road. This work will consist of trench excavation within the roadways followed by installation of the new gas main, temporary paving and, finally, restoration of the roadway.

In addition to the abovementioned work, our crews will be installing two gas distribution lines on Roslyn Road. The first distribution line will be installed between Lee Avenue and Jericho Turnpike. The second distribution line will be installed between Westbury Avenue and East 2nd Street.

While construction is in active sections of Roslyn Road will be closed to through traffic. Flaggers will be present to direct traffic as needed. Our project outreach team will provide timelines to local residents and stakeholders with as much notice as possible.

## Our Commitment

We will construct the new infrastructure safely and reliably while sharing information widely so that we can continue to serve our community well into the future. Throughout the project, we will make every possible effort to update our commercial and residential customers and other residents about upcoming actions, impacts and road closures, and maintain an open and proactive dialogue about the project with our neighbors and partners in Nassau County.
